

JUNIOR BIBLE QUIZ

KINDERGARTEN - 6TH GRADE

WHAT: Bible quiz is an exciting and engaging way to deepen your knowledge of the Bible. It is an activity that involves memorizing and studying passages of the Bible and answering questions in a quiz format. Whether you are a beginner or experienced, Bible quiz can help you grow in your faith and understanding of God's Word.

WHY: Participating in JBQ results in increased Biblical literacy. Quizzers learn what the Bible says, how to apply it to our lives, what we believe, and why we believe it. Participants also gain new friendships, learn how to win humbly and lose graciously; and families spend quality time together studying God's Word.

WHO: Children in Kindergarten through 6th grade are eligible to participate in the state of Louisiana. To advance to the Regional or National level, quizzers must be in 1st - 6th grade.

HOW: Teams gather together once a week to learn and practice questions taken from a finite set of 576 questions called the Bible Fact-Pak. They do this through study, games, and challenges. Then, once a month (September – February) teams all across the north gather together to quiz against one another as do teams from the south. In March, the entire state gathers for one final competition where trophies and camp scholarships are given away!

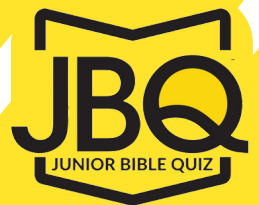
GETTING INVOLVED IN JBQ IS AS EASY AS 1, 2, 3!

STEP ONE: GATHER A TEAM & CHOOSE A DIVISION

JBQ is an intentional discipleship plan for kids in the local church or Christian schools. Find kids and parents interested in growing in their knowledge and love of the Bible. A team consists of 2-8 quizzers, a coach, and an optional assistant coach. You will also want kids 7th grade and up, as well as adults, that will serve as tournament officials. We offer a Searchers league for quizzers kindergarten - 3rd grade and a Masters league for 4th - 6th grade. Teams are also welcome to combine kids of all ages. It's whatever works best for you! 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STEP TWO: PREPARE FOR THE MEETS

Where do the questions come from?

All questions are taken from the NLT JBQ Fact-Pak. Visit <https://biblefactpak.com> to purchase materials or to access the free question generator. You can print questions from specific numbers, themes, and custom sets with the generator.

Where can I get a quizbox?

It is also highly recommended to purchase 1-2 extra handpads. It is not necessary to immediately purchase a quizbox. However, it will be extremely helpful to your team.

How do I organize practice time?

What is the Bible Master Award?

Want to champion children for learning the Bible? If so, the Bible Master Award program is for you! This program is a special memorization award that individuals can earn based on learning questions from the Bible Fact-Pak. There are four levels; three are earned on the network level, and the fourth is earned on the national level! See the Season Packet for more details.

STEP THREE: REGISTER THE TEAM

The District JBQ Director will email registration forms to each JBQ Coordinator/Coach that has filled out the interest form. These registration forms typically go out two weeks prior to a monthly tournament and must be returned one week prior. Registration fees of \$100 for your 1st team, \$75 for the 2nd, \$50 for the 3rd, etc are collected at the first tournament of each season. As an added incentive to help churches start a JBQ program, each church will be able to wave their registration fees the first year of participation!
