8. After Jesus walked and talked with His apostles following His resurrection, what happened to Him?

He was taken up into a cloud until they could no longer see Him.

9. Quote the verse that says Jesus is always the same.

“Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.” (Hebrews 13:8)

10. What is the Christian's Blessed Hope?

The return of Jesus [Christ]
