Location: Campground – Under or near the Covered area surrounding the Office next to the Cafeteria.

Cost: No Entry Fee

Date: Friday – Judging from 4:30 – 5 PM – (Men's Retreat Meal to begin being served at 5:00 PM.)

Categories: Fried / Smoked / Gumbo or soup / Grilled or BBQ / Jambalaya / Stew or Gravy over rice

Category Award – 1st Place Medal to be given to the winning team of Each Category entered.

Scoring – Taste = 100% of the score (Total points scored from 5 Judges = Final Score per category.)

In case of a tie, the Men's Director along with the Activity Coordinator & His Assoc. will vote.

Grand Prize Trophy: The winning team from each of the categories listed above, each have an equal chance to win the **Grand Prize Trophy**, for their church. The Highest Point Count Earned, **In Any Category Entered** - Determines the Overall winning team.

RULES

- Each "Church Team" will have a team CAPTAIN and consist of 1 – 6 members.
- Any church may enter up to TWO teams maximum.
- Each team must display their CHURCH NAME and TEAM NAME on a sign at their booth.
- Each team will begin cooking on Friday at a time necessary to serve the judges (4:30-5PM)
- Each team will prepare and serve a minimum of 30 servings per category entered.
- Each team will be given a 10 x 10 covered area to work in. Please provide your own table.
- Each team will be responsible to protect the pavement from cooking oils, grease, or spills.
- Each team may enter in up to 3 categories. You may cook and share any amount of food items throughout the afternoon, but you can only enter for competition (with a minimum of 25 servings per item plus the 5 for judging) up to a maximum of 3 entries per team.
- You will be presenting servings of your entry, one to each of 5 judges. (3 – 5 minutes max)
- All team scores will be revealed at the Awards Ceremony on Saturday. This will allow teams to see their standings, as well as, to strategize for future Annual Competitions.

Rules: Shooters furnishes gun and standard load shells. Guns may be shared but not during the same shooting line up. **Shooters Must Wear Ear and Eye Protection while shooting.** The Activity Coordinator has the authority to inspect and determine if the firearm is permitted to be used.

- All shells will be standard load. Shooter may shoot up to two times at his designated target.
- Shooter must shoot with plug in gun - maximum of 2 shells in your gun at any time.
- Shooter must Provide and Wear **Ear & Eye Protection**, while competing at the Range.
- Only one entry per person this tournament.
- **Novice shooters should gain experience at the campground non-competition skeet shoot prior to entering the Range Tournament Competition.**

Spectators Are Welcome, And Are Encouraged To Participate, At Either Location.

Prize Award: Winning Team will be given Individual Medals

Rules:

- Coin flip or Odd/Even winner gets lane choice - Loser picks who throws first.
- Your feet may not go past the front edge of the board. If they do, a foul is called and bag is discounted.
- A player must pitch each bag within fifteen (15) seconds of their opponents bag coming to rest.
- Players at the headboard will alternate pitching bags until each player has pitched his four bags.
- After all bags have been thrown, a bag remaining on the board is worth 1 point. A bag that went in the hole is worth 3 points. Any bag touching both the board and the ground will not be counted. A bag that hits the ground first and bounces onto the board will not count and will be taken off the board immediately.
- Add up how many points you have earned and compare them to your opponents. Equal points cancel each other out so that only one team can score per round.
- A game is won when a team reaches 21 points with a lead of 2 or more points.
- Each player or team is allowed two "1 Minute Time Outs" per game.
- A player may only call a "Time Out" when it is his turn to pitch.

**The Activity Coordinator has the authority to amend or alter any rules or conditions.
The Activity Coordinator has the right to disqualify any person or team that "Exhibits Un-Sportsman Like Conduct." All decisions made by the Activity Coordinator are final.**

Dress: Decently appropriate for basketball.

Team Restrictions: Church teams limited to 4 male players age 15 & up. Churches may have multiple teams. Individuals not part of a Church team may form a separate team.

Rules: Each team will play at least two games to determine tournament seat. First team to 10 wins (subject to Coordinators rulings with respect to time) Fouls result in loss of possession. If the shot is missed and the ball hits the rim, and the opposing team gets the rebound, the ball must clear the top of the key. If a change of possession, you must "Check Up" before play. After "Check Up," the ball is live. After 4 team fouls, the opposing team get 1 Free Throw.

Scoring Is As Follows: 1 pt. and 2 pt. scoring style. 2 pt scoring outside of 3 pt. line. 2 game eliminations, meaning after actual tournament begins, if you lose twice your participation is over. Championship game will be to 12 points.

Penalties and Disqualifications: Arguing with officials will immediately disqualify your team and any other team from your church. Other grounds for dismissal include swearing or foul language, griping or complaining, and violation of any tournament rule. The Activity Coordinator has the authority to alter or change any rule or condition associated with the Activity. The Activity Coordinator's decisions are final.
